1. QUESTION

2. LAYING OF PAPER

Pu C.Chawngkunga, Minister laid on the Table a Copy of the Mizoram (Small loans to Economically Weaker Section) Rule, 1983.

3. GRANTS AND VOTING ON SUPPLEMENTAY DEMAND FOR GRANTS FOR 1975-76.
