Pu C.Vulluaia	<p>“This Assembly is of the opinion that cost of water connection to the residence of Hon’ble Members of the Assembly and the water charges thereto and also cost of the Hon’ble Members of the Assembly and the power consumption bills be borne by State Govt. with effect from April, 1979.”</p>
4.	Pu H. Rammawi	<p>“This Assembly is of the opinion that Micro-Hydel Project on ‘Chelui’ (Tlabung Point) be taken up by Government of Mizoram.”</p>
5.	Pu Bualhranga Pu J.Thankunga	<p>“This Assembly is of the opinion that the Government of Mizoram should take early step to construct Mizoram House at Vellore, Tamil Nadu.”</p>
