ADMINISTRATOR'S RECOMMENDATION FOR INTRODUCTION AND  
CONSIDERATION OF THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (NO. 3) BILL, 1984.

The following communication dated 19<sup>th</sup> March, 1984 has been received from the Administrator of Mizoram:-

“I, H.S. Dubey, Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram, recommend under sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Government of Union Territories Act, 1963 (Central Act 20 of 1963) that the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 3) Bill, 1984 be introduced and moved in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly. I also recommend under sub-section (3) of section 23 of the said Act, the consideration of the said Bill by the Mizoram Legislative Assembly.”
