PROGRAMME OF LT. GOVERNOR'S ADDRESS TO ASSEMBLY ON 28<sup>TH</sup> MAY, 1979

1. Members are informed that as provided in rule 16 (1) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Mizoram Legislative Assembly the Lt. Governor (Administrator) will address the Assembly on Monday, the 28<sup>th</sup> May, 1979 at 10:30 A.M.
2. Members are requested to be in their seats in the Assembly Hall by 10:20 A.M. on the 28<sup>th</sup> May, 1979.
3. On arrival at the gate of the Assembly House, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) will be received by the Speaker and the Secretary of the Assembly. Thereafter, the Lt. Governor will be conducted to the Assembly Hall in a procession and his entry will be announced by the Marshall.
4. All Members will rise in their seats as soon as the announcement is made and resume their seats after the Lt. Governor has taken his seat.
5. The 1<sup>st</sup> Assam Rifles Band Party will play the National Anthem.
6. The Lt. Governor will then address the House.

7. At the conclusion of the Address, the Lt. Governor will resume his seat for a few seconds. When the Lt. Governor again rises, all Members will rise and remain standing. The Assam Rifles Band Party will play the National Anthem again. The Lt. Governor leaves the Hall in a procession.
8. After the Lt. Governor has left, the Members will disperse and re-assemble in the Assembly Hall ten minutes after the Lt. Governor has left, for transaction of business of the House as per list of business for the day.

RULES TO BE OBSERVED BY MEMBERS

RULE No. 265 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Mizoram Legislative Assembly is reproduced below for information of Members:

While the House is sitting, a member-

- (i) Shall not read any book, newspaper or letter except in connection with the business of the House;
- (ii) Shall not interrupt any member while speaking by improper expression or noises in any other improper manner;
- (iii) Shall bow to the Chair while taking or leaving his seats;
- (iv) Shall not pass between the Chair and any member who is speaking;
- (v) Shall not leave the House when the Speaker is addressing the House;
- (vi) Shall always address the Chair;

- (vii) Shall keep to his usual seat;
- (viii) Shall maintain silence when not speaking in the House;
- (ix) Shall not applaud when a stranger enters any of the Galleries, or the Special Box;
- (x) Shall not while speaking, make any reference to the strangers in any of the Galleries;
- (xi) Shall not obstruct proceedings, hiss or interrupt and shall avoid making running commentaries when speeches are being made in the House.
