The following communications dated 10th March, 1981 have been received from the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram:

I. RECOMMENDATION FOR LAYING SUPPLEMENTARY DEMANDS FOR 1980-81

“I, N.P. Mathur, Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram, recommend for laying the Statement of Supplementary Demands for additional expenditure for 1980-81 before the Legislative Assembly of the Union Territory of Mizoram with the previous approval of the President of India as required under Section 27 (1) of the Govt. of Union Territories Act, 1963.”

II. RECOMMENDATION FOR MAKING SUPPLEMENTARY DEMANDS FOR 1980-

81

“I, N.P. Mathur, Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram, recommend for making of additional Demand for 1980-81 in the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram for Rs. 6,00,19,000/-

(Rupees six crores and nineteen thousands) only as detailed in the Supplementary Demand/Grant Book, as required under Section 28 (3) of the Govt. of Union Territories Act, 1963 (As amended).”

III. RECOMMENDATION FOR LAYING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT FOR
1981-82

“I, N.P. Mathur, Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram, recommend for laying the Annual Financial Statement for 1981-82 before the Legislative Assembly of the Union Territory of Mizoram with the previous approval of the President of India as required by Section 27 (1) of the Govt. of Union Territories Act, 1963.”

IV. RECOMMENDATION FOR MAKING DEMAND FOR GRANTS FOR 1981-82

“I, N.P. Mathur, Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram, recommend for making Demand for Grants for 1981-82 in the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram for Rs. 83,58,99,000.00 (Rupees eighty-three crores fifty-eight lakhs and ninety-nine thousands) only as per details given in the Annual Financial Statement, as required under Section 28 (3) of the Government of Union Territories Act, 1963 (As amended).”
