

# MIZORAM LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

## BULLETIN PART I

(Brief Record of Proceedings)

No. 4 (10:30 A.M)                      Monday, the 26<sup>th</sup> June, 1978.

### 1. Announcement

The Speaker announced that 4 persons belonging to the Mizoram Congress Party, namely, Pu Lal Thanhawla, Pu C.L. Ruala, Pu H.K. Chakma and Pu Sainghaka were elected as members of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly in the general election held in May, 1978. Also, Pu Kisto Mohan, an independent Member has joined the Mizoram Congress Legislature Group. The Mizoram Congress Legislature Group thus consists of 5 members with Pu Lal Thanhawla and Pu Sainghaka as its condition of the principle for recognition of a Legislature Group, they are recognized as the main Opposition Group in the House.

### 2. Papers laid on the Table:

Pu Thenphunga Sailo, Chief Minister laid on the Table of the House:

- (i) Government of Mizoram (Local Administration Department) Order No. LAD A-9/76/136 dated 12.4.77 regarding Chakma District Council;
- (ii) Government of Mizoram Order No.LAD/A-9/76/179-180 dated 23.9.77 regarding Chakma District Council;
- (iii) Explanatory Memorandum giving reasons for action taken under the proviso to paragraph 16(2) of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India in relation to Chakma District Council as required by paragraph 16(3) of the said Schedule.

### 3. Presentation of Budget

Pu Lalhmingthanga, Minister i/c Finance presented the Budget of the Government of Mizoram for 1978-79.

### 4. Announcement

The Speaker announced that Biennial Election to fill a seat in the Council of States from Mizoram was in progress. The Returning Officer expected to declare the result of the election at 3:00 P.M. in Committee Room of the Assembly House. Those Members who wished to be present at the time of declaration of result of election were welcome to be present at the appointed time.

5. According to the provisional Calendar of Business Tuesday, the 27<sup>th</sup> June, 1978 was allotted for Private Members' Business. Some resolutions had been received from Members, but as the prescribed could not be included in the list of business for the next day allotted for Private Members' Business, i.e. 30<sup>th</sup> June, 1978. Therefore, there would be no sitting of the House on 27.6.78.
6. Wednesday, the 28<sup>th</sup> June, 1978 was allotted for Government business. As no Government business was ready to be brought up before the House on 28.6.78, the Speaker announced that there would be no sitting of the House on that day.
7. The House adjourned at 11:38 A.M. till 10:30 A.M. on Thursday, the 29<sup>th</sup> June, 1978.
