NOTIFICATIONS

No. DCA/E-186/82/28, the 25th October, 1982. Whereas by Notification No. DCA/E. 108/79/28 dt.7.1.82 issued in pursuance of Sub rule (1) of rule 7 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram has been pleased to allocate 10 elected seats for the District Council for the Chakma Autonomous District;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (2) of rule 7 of the said rules, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to direct that -

(i) The Chakma Autonomous District shall be divided for the purpose of elections to the aforesaid District Council into 10 territorial constituencies, as specified in column 2 of the table below.

(ii) the extent of each constituency shall be as shown in the corresponding entries in column 3 thereof ; and

(iii) each such constituency shall elect one member.
