Terms of Appointment 1. The Government Advocate for Civil Cases at Aizawl hereinafter referred to as the Government Advocate) shall be appointed by the Administrator of the Union Territory, Mizoram (Hereinafter referred to as the Administrator). The appointment shall be for a period of one year in the first instance and may be renewed for further periods if the incumbent is found fit and efficient.

Provided that the appointment may be terminated at any time by one months notice in writing given either by the Government Advocate to the Administrator or by the Administrator to the Government Advocate.

When the Government Advocate is employed to conduct a case or deputation attend the court work or other official work outside his Headquarters he shall be allowed TA/DA as admissible to Group 'A' Officers to others Stations. of the Govt. of Mizoram. No TA and DA shall be allowed for joining duty or on termination of engagement.

Explanation :- For the purpose of this rule the headquarters of the Government Advocate shall be Aizawl and he must reside at Aizawl.

Work for 9. The Government Advocate will, when required and permitted by other Govt. the Administrator, work for any other Government in India at the same rate of fee as for Government of Mizoram. Where such other Government in India normally utilise the services of the Government Advocate for work in Mizoram, the latter will, as in the case of Government of Mizoram, tender advice free.
