Mizoram Act No. 2 of 1983

The Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1983

(Received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram on the 31st March, 1983).

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1983-84.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one hundred and eleven crores eighty seven lakhs and ninety-one thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1983-84 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
