AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1983— 84.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- This Act may be called the Mizoran
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram there may be paid in d applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule and unting in the aggregate to the sum of one hundred and eleven crores eight neven lakks and ninety-one thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1983. B4 in respect of the services specified in column, 2 of the Schedule.
- 3. The sums author sed to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
