NOTIFICATION

S.O. Whereas the Election Commission of India is satisfied that as a result of its poll performance at the general election to the Legislative Assembly of Andra Pradesh State held in January, 1983. Teluga Desam is entitled for recognition as a State Party in the State of Andra Pradesh in terms of paragraph 6 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968.

And whereas the Commission has decided to recognise Telugu Desam as a State Party in the State of Andra Pradesh and reserve 'Bicycle' for the said Party in Andra Pradesh State;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clause (b) of sub-paragraph (1) and sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 17 of the said symbols Order, the Election Commission hereby makes the following amendments in its notification No. 56/82 dated 8th April, 1982, published as O. N. 29 (E) in the Gazette of India, Extra-ordinary, Part II, Section 3 (III) dated 12th April, 1982, as amended from time to time, namely—

- (2) IN TABLE 4 of the said notification, against the State of 1 Andra Pradesh, under column 2, the entry '1. Bicycle' shall be deleted and the existing entires 2 to 15 shall be renumbered as 1 to 14.

The recognition granted above is also subject to the following conditions:—

- (i) The party shall communicate to the Commission without delay and change in its name, head Office, office bearers, address and political principles, politics, aims and objectives and any change in any other material matters;
- (ii) The party shall intiate the Commission immediately whenever any amendments are issued to party Constitution along with the relevant documents like the notice for the meeting to consider amendments, agenda for the meeting, minutes of the meeting where the amendments have been carried etc.;
- (iii) The party shall maintain all the records like minute Book, account books, membership registers, receipt books, etc. properly.
- (iv) The said records shall be open for inspection at any time by the authorised representative(s) of the Commission; and
- (v) The recognition granted shall be reviewed by the Commission from time to time.
