No. 464/MIZ/HP/72 (1):— Whereas an election is required to be held by Section 18 of the North—Eastern Areas (Reorganisation) Act 1971 (81 of 1971), to elect a representative from the Mizoram (ST) Parliamentary constituency in the Union Territory of Mizoram as if the seat of the member elected to the House of the People from that constituency has become vacant.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the provisions of section 149 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission hereby calls upon the said constituency to elect before the 28th April, 1972, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder, a person who is a member of any of the Scheduled Tribes to fill the said seat.

No. 464/MIZ/HP/72(2).— In pursuance of the provisions of section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission hereby appoints, with respect to the election to be held in Mizoram (ST) Parliamentary constituency in the Union Territory of Mizoram in pursuance of its notification No. 464/MIZ/HP/72 (1) dated the 17th March, 1972.

- (a) the 24th March, 1972 (Friday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 25th March, 1972 (Saturday), as the date for the scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) the 28th March 1972 (Tuesday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures ;
- (d) the 18th April, 1972 (Tuesday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and
- (e) the 28th April, 1972 (Friday), as the date before which the election shall be completed.

No. 464/MIZ/HP/72(3).— In pursuance of section 56 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission hereby fixes the hours from 7 A.M. to 5 P.M. as the hours during which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken for the election to the House of the People from Mizoram (ST) Parliamentary constituency, to be held in pursuance of its notification No. 464/MIZ/HP/72(1), dated the 17th. March, 1972
