## NOTIFICATION

No.A.33026/2/89-ED (A), the 29th January 1993,  
Mizoram finds it expedient to amend the Mizoram Pre-Matric Merit Scholarship Rules, 1990, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to amend the said rules as follows :-

Short title,  
extent and  
commencement

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Pre-Matric Merit Scholarship (Amendment) Rules, 1993.
- (2) They shall have the like extent as the principal Rules.
- (3) They shall come into force on the date of publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

Amendment  
of rule 4

2. In the Mizoram Pre-Matric Merit Scholarship Rules, 1990 (herein above and after referred to as the Principal Rules) for sub-Rule(1) substituted, namely :-

### “4. Categories of Scholarships

- (1) For the purpose of these rules, there shall be the following three categories of Scholarships namely :-
  - (a) Primary School Leaving Merit Scholarships :
  - (b) Middle School Leaving Merit Scholarships :  
and
  - (c) Middle English School Leaving Merit Scholarships”

Amendment  
of rule 5.

3. In the Principal Rules, for rule 5, the following rules shall be substituted, namely :-



“5. Number, value and duration of Scholarships

(1) The numbers of these

(2) The value of each scholarship shall be Rs. 100/- for Primary School Leaving Merit Scholarship per head per mensem and Rs. 150/- for the Middle School Leaving Merit Scholarship and the Middle English School Leaving Merit Scholarship per head per mensem.

(3) These Scholarships shall be tenable for twelve months each year for three consecutive year in classes V, VI, and VII for clause (a) of sub-rule (1) of rule 4 and for three consecutive years in classes VIII, IX and X for clauses (b) & (c) of sub-rule (1) of rule 4 subject to satisfactory progress and attendance of the scholarship holders in any recognised institution in the State of Mizoram.”
