#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF AIZAWL WEST SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION DIVISION.

Headquarters : Aizawl.  
Area : 2210 Km Sq (Approx)

GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION: It lies between  $92^{\circ} 16'$  to  $92^{\circ} 53'$  East Longitude and  $24^{\circ} 2'$  to  $23^{\circ} 15'$  North Latitude.

#### BOUNDARY DETAILS:

1) NORTHERN SIDE : The boundary line starts from the confluence of Tlawng and Tut in the North western corner near Tlangkhang village and then it follows the Tlawng river in easterly direction. It then follows the Inter-Block boundary line of Thingdawl and Tlangnuam Blocks till it meets the Tuirial river.

2) EASTERN SIDE : The boundary line then turns in southerly direction by following the upstream side of the Tuirial river till it meets the confluence of the Mawngping and Mat river.

3) SOUTHERN SIDE : The boundary then turns towards the westerly direction by following the Mawngping river and Changte river upto the confluence of the Tlawng and Changte river. Then the boundary line follows river Tlawng in southerly direction upto the Inter district boundary line of Aizawl and Lunglei District. Then the Boundary goes along the Inter-district boundary line of Aizawl and Lunglei in Westerly direction till it meets the International boundary line of India and Bangladesh.

4) WESTERN SIDE : Lastly, the boundary line turns towards in northerly direction which follows the International boundary line of India and Bangladesh and then it follows the Inter-Block boundary line of Zawlnuam and West Phaileng block upto the Tut river. Then the boundary line follows the Tut river in northerly direction till it meets the starting point.
