AN
ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the services of the financial year, 1993-94

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1993.

Issue of Rs 554,40,19,000.00 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the financial year 1993-94.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and be applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column 3 of Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of five hundred fifty four crores forty lakhs nineteen thousand towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1993-94 in respect of the services specified in Column 2 of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
