### NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 29 (2) OF THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY ACT, 1948 AS AMENDED

**NAME OF SCHEME : TRANSMISSION SYSTEM ASSOCIATED WITH  
TUIVAI HYDRO ELECTRIC PROJECT.**

No. B, 18013/1/90-P&E/Pt, the 22nd September, 1993. Notification on the Tuivai Hydro Electric Project under Section 29 (2) of the Electricity Supply Act 1948 on Transmission Associated with Tuivai Hydro Electric Project.

Whereas the Department of Power & Electricity Department, Mizoram, Aizawl, a Government organisation has proposed the construction of the following project relating to the Establishment, construction, operation and maintenance of Sub-Station and Transmission lines etc., Sub-Station at Aizawl (Zuangtui) and another at Serchhip for evaluating the power from Tuivai Project at (132 KV).

Whereas under Section 29(2) of the said Act, the Power & Electricity Department is required to publish the said scheme in the Official Gazette.

Now, therefore, the Department of Power & Electricity hereby publish the said scheme in compliance with the said Section of Electricity Supply Act, 1948.

### SCHEME TRANSMISSION LINES AND ASSOCIATED SUB-STATION TRANSMISSION LINES (132 KV Transmission lines).

- 1) 220 KV Tuivai — Seling (120 Km)  
220 KV Tuivai — Jeribum (80 Km)
- 2) 220 KV Tuivai — Badarpur (160 Km)  
132 KV Line Tuivai—Ngopa (15 Km)  
132 KV Tuivai — Darlawn (15 Km)



With loop in and loop out at PGCi existing line.

220/132 KV S/C at Seling

With loop in and loop out Aizawl/Saitual.  
Aizawl — Serchhip  
PGCI Jeribum/Aizawl.

#### COMMISSIONING SCHEDULE :

The transmission system associated with Tuivai Hydel Project is likely to be completed within 9th Plan.

#### ADVANTAGES :

The Project, will enable to evacuate power from Tuivai Hydro Electric Project, to give more power and help industrial growth of the State.

#### POWER FOR PLACING TRANSMISSION LINES, TOWERS ETC :

For placing transmission lines, towers wires, equipments and appliances for transmission and distribution of electricity (or) for transmission of telephonic telegraphic communication necessary for the purpose of undertaking executing operating the scheme, the Department of Power & Electricity shall be in accordance with the provision of Section 42 of Indian Electricity Supply Act, 1948, and shall exercise all the powers which the telegraphic Authority possess under Part-III of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1985 with respect of telegraph lines established (or) maintained.

Also notice is hereby given inviting licencees and other interested persons who are likely to be affected to make representations on the scheme to undersigned within a period of (two) months with effect from the date of publication in the official Gazette for consideration.
