The Mizoram Appropriation (No. 1) Act 1994.

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 24th March, 1994,)

AN

ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the services of the financial year, 1993—94.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 1) Act, 1994.

Issue of Rs. 1,08,49,26,000.00 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the financial year 1993—94.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and be applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rupees one hundred eight crores forty nine lakhs twenty six thousand only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1993—94 in respect of the services specified in Column 2 of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
