#### NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/4/85-P&AR(C), the 11th October, 1994. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Language instructor for Stenography in the ITI under Labour & Employment Department, Govt. of Mizoram namely:

- I. Short title (i) These rules may be called the Mizoram L&E Department and commencement. (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1994.
  - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.

The Rules shall apply to the post specified in Col. I of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.

The number of the said post(s) their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 to the Annexure—I aforesaid.

4. Method of (4) rectt. age limit and other qualification.

The age limit qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Annexure-I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidate belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification:

No person,

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;
- (b) Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any other persons, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of Rules.

6. Training and Departmental Examination.

Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

6(a) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts/service specified in schedule/Annexure to these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grades.

7. Power to relax.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reason to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions and these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Reservation. other concessions.

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central/State Govt, from time to time in this regards.

9. Repeal & Saving.
