ORDER

No. A. 12031/2/90—HMP, the 20th November, 1994. Whereas it has come to the notice of the Government that some employees of the Government of Mizoram have resorted to strike and have remained absent from their places of duty;

And whereas the Governor of Mizoram, having regard to the circumstances prevailing in the State of Mizoram, is satisfied that in the public interest, it is necessary to prohibit strike in certain essential services;

And whereas any service connected with Public Health, Sanitation, Hospitals, Dispensaries and Health Centres has been specified as essential services under the Mizoram Essential Services Maintenance Act, 1990 (Mizoram Act No. 15 of 1990).

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Mizoram Essential Services Maintenance Act, 1990 (Mizoram Act No. 15 of 1990), the Governor is pleased to prohibit strike in any service connected directly or indirectly with the functioning of Public Health, Sanitation, Hospitals, Lispensaries and Health Centres in the State

No person employed in any essential service to which this order relates shall go or remain on strike or remain absent from his/her place of duty.

Any strike by persons employed in any service connected with Public Health, Sanitation, Hospitals, Dispensaries and Health Centres commencing before or after the issuance of this order shall be illegal and any violation shall be liable to punishment in accordance with the provisions of law for the time being in force in the State.

This order shall take immediate effect and shall remain in force for a period of six months unless revoked earlier.
