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NOTIFICATION

No.B-11011/14/90-FST, the 7th December 1994. In pursuance of the Government of India's Notification No.F.No.1-1/92-PT dt. 20.10.1994, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to establish 500 Sq. Kms. composite area of Dampa Wildlife Sanctuary in Aizawi District of Mizoram as a "Tiger Reserve" under the Centrally Sponsored (Plan) Scheme "Project Tiger" as specified below. No area within the limits of 500 Sq. Kms. will be diverted for any other purpose without prior approval of the Central Government.

THE DAMPA TIGER RESERVE

i) District

: Aizawl District

ii) Location

: Western site of Mizoram along the international border.

iii) Name of the Forest

: Dampa

iv) Class of Forests

: Reserved and Unclassed forests.

v) Area vi) BOUNDARIES 500 Sq. Kms.

The boundaries of Dampa Tiger Reserve will stand as follows:

NORTH:

Boundary starts from the point where Sailui meets Sazalui (also known as Tuiliaupui) and thence follows Sailui upstream upto the source and thence proceeds straight eastward crossing Persang ridge-line meeting Thaichanglui upstream where it meets Border Road Task Force Road. Thence the boundary follows upstream of Thaichanglui upto about hundred metres and turns towards north running parallel to the ridge of Hachhek tlang upto tributory of Kawrthindenglui thence it follows and meets Katamoni-Tlabung (Demagiri) road. Thence it follows the said road towards South-East where it meets B.R.T.F road towards east upto river Teirei.

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From the point where B.R.T.F. road and Teirei river meet, the boundary thence follows Teirei river upto its source and thence to the saddle where it meets Phaileng-Marpara B.R.T.F. road. Thence the boundary follows W.Phaileng-Marpara B.R.T.F. road southward upto Tuikhur lui steam near Phuldungsei.

SOUTH: Thence the boundary follows Tuikhurlui stream westward crossing inter-village footpath of Phuldungsei and Saithah crossing Vaisamtlang. Thence it follows another stream, Thingthupuilui from its source towards west down stream upto the meeting point with Hmarluanglui. Thence follows Hmarluanglui upstream south-wards upto its source which is saddle and after crossing the saddle it meets the source of Aivapui lui. Thence the boundary follows Aivapui lui downstream southwards and south-west where it meets Tuilianpui (Sazalui).

WEST: Thence the boundary follows Tuilianpui (Sazalui) upstream till its meeting point with Sailui (starting point),

There shall be a buffer cated in the map (as buffer area I, II, III and IV).
