NOTIFICATION

No. H-14011/3/92-DCA/Part. I, the 27th January, 1995. Whereas under the provision of sub-paragraph (6A) of paragraph 2 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, read with sub-rule (1) of rule 8 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974, as amended from time to time, the life time of an Autonomous District Council, unless sooner dissolved, is 5 years from the date appointed for the first meeting of the Council after General Election to the Council.

And Whereas the General Election of the Mara Autonomous District Council was held on 6.2.1990 and the first meeting of the Council was held on 12.2.1990 where election of the Chairman of the Council was held and a period of 5 years therefrom is expiring on 11.2.1995;

And whereas the Government, vide Notification No. H-14011/3/92-DCA dt. 4.1.1995, have appointed the 9.2.1995 on which poll of the Mara Autonomous District shall be taken by holding a General Election and the 15.2.1995 being appointed for election of Chairman which will be the tirst meeting of the Council and thereby the life time of the said Council will exceed by 3 days.

Now therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by lirst proviso to sub-paragraph (6A) of paragraph 2 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution, read with proviso to sub-rule (1) of Rule 8 of the Mizoram (Constitution and Conduct of Business of Autonomous District Councils) Rules, 1974 as amended from time to time, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to extend the life time of the present Mara Autonomous District Council by 3 (three) days with effect from 12,2.1995 to 14.2.1995.
