The Mizoram Appropriation (No.1) Act, 1995

Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 30th March, 95.

ACT

THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (NO. 1) ACT, 1995

(As passed by the Legislative Assembly on the 20th March, 1995)

BE in enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows :

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 1) Act, 1995.

Issue of Rs 154,72,20,000.00 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the financial year 1994-95.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column 3 of Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one hundred fifty four crores, seventy two lakhs, twenty thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1994-95, in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriate for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
