NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/40/80-APT (B), the 5th May, 1995. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram hereby makes the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts(s) of Assistant Soil Conseivation Officer, Instructor-cum Hostel Superintendent Under Soil & Water Conservation Department, namely:-

- Short title and 1. commencement:
- (i) These rules may be called the Mizoram Soil & Water Conservation Department (Group 'B' Gazetted post) Recruitment Rules, 1995.
- (ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application:

The Rules shall apply to the post(s) specified in Col. 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.

Number of posts, classification and scale of pay:

The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 to the Annexure-I aforesaid.

Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification:

The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Annexure-I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories or persons by 5 years or in accordance with the orders issued by Government of Mizoram from time to time.

Disqualification:

No person—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living. 'or'

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any other persons shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that Governor may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Training and Departmental Examination:
- a) Selected candidates will have to undergo regular Gazetted Soil Conservation Training and Forest Diploma Course within 3 years of service. Unless the candidates complete the required training, they will not be confirmed in the post and they will also be liable to discharged from service.
- b) Selected candidates shall pass such Departmental Examination or undergo such training as may be prescribed from time to time.
- 7. Power to relax:

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reason to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category or persons.

8. Reservation, other concessions:

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.

9. Repeal & Saving:

All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were inforce in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs

(ii) dt. 21.1.1972 and Notification No. A. 12018/40/80-APT (B) dt. 4.6.87, No. A. 12018/40/80-APT(B) dt. 18.9.91 and No. A. 12018/40/80-APT(B) dt. 22.2.94, are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
