### NOTIFICATION

No. B. 17011/15/89-TRP, the 30th May, 1995. In supersession of this Department's Notification of even No. dated 14th February, 1991 and in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 200 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No 59 of 1988), the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to authorise the following Officers to compound Traffic offences committed under the said Act and punishable under Sections mentioned in column 2 of the Schedule below for amounts not more than the ones specified in corresponding column 2 of the Schedule below for amounts not more than the ones specified in corresponding column of the said Schedule :--

1. Director of Transport.
2. Joint Directors of Transport.
3. Deputy Director of Transport (Operations)
4. District Transport Officers/Assistant Directors of Transport, Transport Department.
5. Motor Vehicle Inspectors.
6. Enforcement-Cum-Traffic Inspectors.
7. Any Police Officer of Traffic Branch not below the rank of Sub-Inspector of Police.

The compounded fee shall be deposited by the Compounding Officers immediately to the Treasury under the Head of Account “—0041 Taxes on Vehicles—800 other receipt (1)” and a copy of the Treasury Challan with a list of offenders furnished to the concerned District Transport Officer, for making necessary endorsements in the Licences wherever required.
