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5. Disqualification : No person,  
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, 'or'

- (b) who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any persons shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the Governor may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

6. **Training and Departmental Examination :** Every Govt. servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. **Power to relax:** Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with Mizoram Selection Board, relax any of the Provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
8. **Reservation, other concessions:** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.
9. **Repeal & Saving:** All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dated 21.1.1972 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
