NOTIFICATION

No, A. 12018/13/82-APT(B), the 2nd February, 1996: In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to Article 300 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules, relating to the recruitment to the post of Dy S.R. (Communication) Covernment of Mizoram namely:

- 1. Short title : and commencement.
- i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram, Police Radio Organisation (Group, A' post), Recruitment Rules, 1996.
- ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette:

The age limit, qualifications and willer matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column 5 to 14 of the said American Is.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct representations may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Govt. of Mizuran from time to time.

·5. Disquali-: fication

No person,

- a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted b) marriage with any persons, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Mizoram may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

Training and: 6. Departmental Examination

Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

6(a) Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts/service specified in scheduleed/Annexure to these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

7. Power to . relax

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Reservation. : other concessions.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
