THE UTTAR PRADESH APPROPRIATION (VOTE ON ACCOUNT)

No. 2 ACT, 1996

AN

ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttar Pradesh for the services of a part of the financial year 1996-97.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as fellows:—

1. This Act may be called the Uttar priation (Vote on Account) No. 2 Act, 1996.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttar Pradesh there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Uttar Pradesh Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1996] to the sum of twenty thousand nine hundred and forty-eight crores, forty-two lakhs and ten thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1996-97 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Withdrawal of Rs. 209 48,42,10,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttar Pradesh for the financial year 1996-97.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttar Pradesh by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
