THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR APPROPRIATION (NO. 2) ACT 1996

AN
ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Jammu and Kashmir for the services of the financial year 1996-97.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1996.

Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Jammu and Kashmir there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Jammu and Kashmir Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1996] to the sum of four thousand seven hundred and eighty crores, fifty lakhs and ten thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1996-97 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Issue of Rs. 4780, 50,10,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Jammu and Kashmir for the financial year 1996-97.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Jammu and Kashmir by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
