THE APPROPRIATION (RAILWAYS) No. 3 ACT, 1996

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated

Fund of India for the services of the financial year 1996-97 for the purposes of Railways.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation Short title (Railways) No. 3 Act, 1996.
