No. 117/B/97-MPSC, the 14th March, 1997. Applications from citizens of India are invited for filling up the under mentioned vacant posts. Last date fixed for submission of application is 25.4.1997. Application Forms (in respect of candidates for direct competitive examination) are available from the Office of Mizoram Public Service Commission, Aizawl, D.C. Lunglei/Saiha on cash payment of Rs. 5/- each or on payment of Rs. 10/- by M.O. or by uncrossed I.P.O. drawn in favour of the Secretary, Mizoram Public Service Commission.

1. Name of post : Grade-IV (entry grade) of Mizoram Judicial Service.
2. No. of post : 5 (Five) posts to be filled up by direct Competitive Examination.
3. Name of Department where vacancy exist : Law & Judicial Department.
4. Scale of Pay : Rs. 2200-75-2800-EB-100-4000/-p.m.
5. Qualification required : For 2 (a) & (b) above.
  1. Specific for (a) only
    - (i) Degree in law from any University recognised for the purpose.
    - (ii) Passing of CL-VI standard in Mizo Vernacular.
  2. Specific for (b) only  
Being a member of the Bar and having been practicing as an Advocate in any Court in India for a period not less than 3 yrs. as per the Certificate issued by the Principal District Court or the Bar Association.

6. Age limit : For 2(a) 21-30 years.  
For 2(b) 25-35 years.
7. Reservation if any : As per Govt. standing Order.

Application fee of Rs. 15/- (or Rs. 5/- fee ST/SC applicants) (no application fee required for Members of the Bar) should be paid in the form of an uncrossed IPO drawn in favour of the Secretary, Mizoram Public Service Commission or by Cash payment at the reception Counter of Mizoram Public Service Commission or by depositing into Treasury under the Head : 0051-PSC 102-MPSC (Examination fee etc.).

Documents to be enclosed : a) For Direct Competitive Examination, the prescribed application form duly filled up should be accompanied by copies of the following documents duly Certified by a Gazetted Officer.

- 1) Degree (in Law) Certificate.
- 2) Character Certificate.
- 3) HSLC/HSS Certificate.
- 4) Citizenship Certificate.
- 5) A Certificate to Proof that the applicant had actually Passed Cl-VI standard in Mizo Vernacular.
- 6) Original & Quadruplicate copies of Treasury Challan or Original IPO or Original Cash receipts as the case may be.
- 7) S.T. Certificate.

b) For Members of the Bar; application Written in plain paper Fully stating the particulars of the applicant's address to the Secretary MPSC should be accompanied by the following documents.

- 1) Degree (in law) Certificate.
- 2) Character Certificate.
- 3) HSLC/HSS Certificate.
- 4) Citizenship Certificate.
- 5) A Certificate to proof that the applicant had actually passed Cl-VI standard in Mizo Vernacular.

6) Certificate issued by the Principal District Court or the Bar Association to the effect that the applicant have been practicing as an Advocate in any Court in India for a period not less than 3 years.

7) S.T. Certificate.

Those already in Government Service should apply through proper Channel.

Canvassing directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidate.

Incomplete application will Summarily be rejected.
