## NOTIFICATION

No. DCA/E-108/88, the 25th March, 1997. Whereas by Notification No. DCA/E-108/88 dated 25th March 1997 issued in pursuance of sub-rule (1) of Rule 7 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to allocate 23 (twenty three) elected seats for the District Council of the Lai Autonomous District Council;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (2) of Rule 7 the said rules, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to direct that—

- (i) the Lai Autonomous District shall be divided for the purpose of elections to the aforesaid District Council into 23 (twenty three) territorial constituencies, as specified in Annexure I attached herewith;
- (ii) the extent of each constituency shall be as shown in the corresponding entries in Annexure I thereof; and
  - (iii) each such constituency shall elect one member.

The starting point at Council Veng will be from Zochhuma's road right upto a bridge over Pakhawnglui, from here it straight towards the north to a huge Mango tree by the side of a half completed stone masonry straight to the Council road following the General road for a few meters to a masonry step near the ZBM's bouse, thence following the stone masonry step to a sadle near Thanghula's house, thence following a foot tract by the side of the Emanuel's. Baptist Church finally joining the PWD road at a nallah, following the nallah downstream to Bazar water point thence downwards the stream till it reaches a point where a streamlet joint.
