The Mizoram Act NO. 1 of 1997

The Mizoram Appropriation (NO.1) Act, 1997.

Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 25th March, 1997.

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Services of the Financial year of 1996-97.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty-eight Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

Short Title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No.1) Act, 1997.

Issue of Rs. 2,26,76,28,000/-
out of the Consolidated Fund
of the State of Mizoram for
the Financial Year 1996-97.

2. From an out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees, two hundred twenty six crores, seventy six lakhs, twenty eight thousand only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1996-97, in respect of Service specified in Column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation


3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act, shall be appropriated for the Services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
