No. H.12018/79/97-LJD: The following Act of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly, which received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Act NO. 2 of 1997
The Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) (NO.2) Act, 1997.

Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 25th March, 1997.

ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Services in respect of the months of April, May, June and July, 1997.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty-eight Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short Title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) (No. 2) Act, 1997.

Note on Account for Rs. 2,60,72,60,000/out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the months of April, May, June and July, 1997.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees, two hundred sixty crores seventy two lakes sixty thousands only towards "Vote on Account" for defraying the Several charges which will come in course of payment during the months of April, May, June and July, 1997 in respect of Service specified in Column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act, shall be appropriated for the Services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
