Application: 2. The Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column-I of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidate belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government of Government of Mizoram from time to time.

CONTRACTOR OF THE PARTY OF THE PROPERTY OF

Disqualification: 5. No person,

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having the spouse living; or
- b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

Training 6. and Deputation:

Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

(6)(a) Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest, have the right and power to transter any officer or official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts service specified in schedule/Annexure to these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

Power to 7. refax:

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Reservation, 8. ether concessions:

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central/State Government from time to time in this regard.

Repeal and 9. Saving:

All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMP(ii) dated 21.1.1972 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of these rules.
