THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (NO. 3) ACT, 1997.

AN

ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the composition of the State of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1997—1998.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty-seventh Mear of Republic of India as follows:

Short Title

- Issue of Rs. 85116,37,000 from

 sud out of the Consolidated Fund
 of the State of Mizoram for the
 financial year 1997-1998.
- 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No.3) Act, 1997.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated, Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in the aggregate to the sum of Eight hundred fifty one crees sixteen lakh thirty seven thousand rupess toward defraying the several charges.

which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1997-1998 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule. This includes the sums already paid against the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) (No.2) Bill 1997.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriate for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
