No.H.12018/79/97-LJD, the 4th August, 1997. The following Act of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly, which received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Appropriation (No.3) Act, 1997.

Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 30th. July, 1997.

THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (NO. 3) ACT, 1997.

AN

ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1997-1998.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty-seventh Year of Republic of India as follows:

Short Title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No.3) Act, 1997.

Issue of Rs. 85116,37,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the financial year 1997-1998.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in the aggregate to the sum of Eight hundred fifty one crore sixteen lakh thirty seven thousand rupees toward defraying the several charges

which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1997-1998 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule. This includes the sums already paid against the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) (No.2) Bill 1997.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriate for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
