NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/2/81-APT(B), the 28th August, 1997. In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 30% of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Superintendent (Homes) under Social Welfare Department, Govt. of Mizoram, namely:

- 1. Short title and commencement.
- (i) These rules may be called the Mizoram Social Welfare Department (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1997.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.

These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Col. 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.

Number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.

The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Scheduled.

5. Disqualification: No person-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor, may if so infled that such marriage is permissible under the personal have applicable to such person and the other narry to the warriage and that there are other grounds for so doing excurpt any person from the operation of this Rule.

6. Training and Departmental Examination.

Every Government servant shall andergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time by the Government of Misoram.

7. Power to transfer.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram shall, in public intenst, have the right and power to transfer any other or official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the posts specified in the schedule to these rules, to any other post of position equivalent in rank or grade.

8. Power to relex.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

9. Reservation, other concessions:

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the acheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the laws made or orders issued by the Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

10. Repeal & Saving

All previous Recruitment Rules, if any, mide on the subject, shall stand repealed from the date of commencement of these Rules.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repeated or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provision of these rules.
