NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/16/80-APT(B)/ Vol-1, the 21st August, 1997. In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Printer, Govt. of Mizoram, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Industries Department Group 'C' posts (Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 1997.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette..
2. Application. These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
3. Number of posts, classification & Scale of pay. The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.
4. Method of Rectt., age limit and other qualification. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government and Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.
5. Disqualification. No person,
 - a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; OR

- b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

6. **Training and Departmental Examination.** Every Government servant recruited under these Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. **Power to transfer.** Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Government of Mizoram shall, in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8. **Power to relax.** Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personnel & Admn. Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
9. **Reservation and other concessions.** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
10. **Repeal and Savings.** All Rules pertaining to these Rules under the Industries Department in the Govt. of Mizoram or framed by the Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No.14/21/71-HMT (ii) dated 21.7.72 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provision of these rules.
