The terms of office of members at Sl. 2 to 10 in respect of the above three Districts shall be for the period of 2 years from the date of publication of this Notification and shall on the expiry of the said period continue to hold office until his successor is nominated and shall also be eligible for re-nomination.

The functions of the Vigilance Committee shall be :

- (a) to advise the District Magistrate of any officer authorised by him as to the efforts made, and action taken to ensure that the provisions of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976, and the rules made thereunder are properly implemented.
- (b) to provide for the economic and social rehabilitation of the free bonded labourers.
- (c) to co-ordinate the functions of rural banks and co-operative societies with a view to canalising adequate credit to the freed bonded labourers.
- (d) to keep an eye on the number of offences of which cognizance has been taken under this Act.
- (e) to make a survey as to whether offence of which cognizance ought to be taken under this Act.
- (f) to defend and any suit instituted against a free bonded labourer of a member of his family or any other person dependent on him for the recovery of the whole or part of any bonded debt or any other debt which is claimed by such person to bonded debt.

The Deputy Commissioners of the respective Districts shall provide secretarial Assistance to the Vigilance Committee who shall regulate its own procedure.

This supercedes the earlier Notification of formation of District Committee vide Memo No. L&ED.145/75/108(A) of 26th July 1976.
