NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/39/80-APT(B)/Vol-I, the 17th September 1997. In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Cartographer Grade-III under Land Revenue and Settlement Department, Govt. of Mizoram, namely :-

- 1. Short title and commencement.
- These Rules may be called the Mizoram Land Revenue and Settlement Department (Group C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1997.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.
- These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.
- Scale of pay.
 - Number of posts, The number of the said posts, their classification and the classification & scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Annexure-I.
- Method of fications.
 - The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to Rectt., age limit the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 in and other quali- the said Annexure-I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons by five years or in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Govt. of Mizoram as the case may be, from time to time.

- 5. Disqualification.
- No person, Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a a) person having a spouse living; OR

b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

- 6. Training and Departmental Examination.
- Every Govt, servant recruited under these Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
- 7. Power to transfer.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Government, in public interest, may transfer any officer or official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts specified in the Annexure to these Rules, to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

8. Power to relax.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, if so recommended by the Departmental Promotion Committee or the Selection Board, as the case may be relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

9. Reservation and other concessions.

Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Government of Mizoram, as the case may be from time to time in this regard.

10. Repeal and Savings.

All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and cominmed to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No.14/21/71—HMT (ii) dated 21.7.72 and framed by the Governor of Mizoram under the Notification No. A. 12018/39/80—APT(B) dated 15.6.85 as published in the Mizoram Gazette, Volume XIV, Extra Ordinary Issue No. 23 dated 14.6.85 are hereby repeated.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general order(s) ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been so made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
