The Mandate of the State Level Committee will be as follows :—

— to review the arrangement for conducting door to door surveys for identification and enumeration of bonded labour;

- to review the arrangement for collection and compilation of data on the basis of survey;
- to review the pace of release of bonded labourers under section 21 of the Act and issue of release certificate;
- to review the pace of implementation of rehabilitation efforts;
- to ensure that lapse back to bondage is prevented;
- to attend to public complaints and grievances and the pace of their disposal at various levels.
