THE CONTINGENCY FUND OF INDIA (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1998

No. 4 OF 1998

Promulgated by the President in the Forty-eighth Year
of the Republic of India.

An Ordinance further to amend the Contingency
Fund of India Act, 1950.

WHEREAS the House of the People has been dissolved and the Council of States is not in session and the President ^{circumstances exist} which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Contingency Fund of India (Amendment) Ordinance, 1998.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Act 49 of 1950.

2. In section 2 of the Contingency Fund of India Act, 1950 [as amended by the Contingency Fund of India (Amendment) Ordinance, 1997], for the words "Fourteen thousand seven hundred crores of rupees", the words "thirty-two thousand four hundred and ninety crores of rupees" shall be substituted.
