The Mizoram Act No. 1 of 1998
The Mizoram Appropriation (No.1) Act, 1998

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 24th March, 1998)

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Services of the Financial Year of 1997-98.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Forty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:

Short Title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 1) Act, 1998.

Issue of Rs. 242,24,77, 2000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Financial year 1997-98.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Year Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees two hundred forty two crore twenty-four lakh seventy seven thousand only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the Financial Year 1997-98 in respect of Service specified in Column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation "

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act, shall be appropriated for the Services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
