NOTIFICATION

No.B.19016/7/98-PHE, the 17th March, 1998. Whereas the Assembly Committee constituted vide Notification issued under No. LA/ENQ/96/6 dt. 1.10.96 to enquire into alleged irregularities in the matter of implementation of Greater Lunglei Water Supply Scheme has submitted its Report to the Government of Mizoram;

Whereas the Assembly Committee was of the view that the said scheme was not actually executed on Turnkey basis and all essential characteristics of Turnkey Project have been substituted by the terms and conditions of the Contractual Agreement though the project was treated as Turnkey Project;

And whereas the Assembly Committee has recommended to the Govt. of Mizoram to conduct close study on Turnkey Project for future major schemes.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Assembly Committee in its Report submitted to the Govt. of Mizoram vide No. LA/ENQ/96-Vol. II/48 dt. 7.11.97, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to constitute a Technical Committee on Turnkey Project with the following officers to study and examine the Report of the Assembly Committee and conduct close study on Turnkey Project:

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. To study and examine the observations and recommendations of the Assembly Committee in its Report submitted to the Hon'ble Speaker, Mizoram Legislative Assembly on 5th Nov. 1997 and CPWD Manual and Code in regard to Turnkey Project, and also indicate all the essential characteristics of Turnkey Project.
2. To study and examine the contractual agreement, Tender Notice and other related documents submitted to the Committee by the P.H.E. Department and to indicate whether or not Greater Lunglei Water Supply Scheme was executed on Turnkey basis in the true sense of the Term.
3. To make concrete recommendations for implementation of major projects on Turnkey basis in future.
