NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/21/80-APT(B), the 22nd May, 1998. In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules, relating to the recruitment to the post of Officer i/c Cold Chain under Health & Family Welfare Department Govt. of Mizoram, namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.
- (i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Health & Family Welfare Department (Group'B') (Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 1997.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.

These Rules shall apply to the post(s) specified in column 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.

3. Number of posts, classification & Scale of pay.

The number of the said post, their classification and the seale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Annexure-I aforesaid.

4. Method of Rectt., age limit and other qualification.

The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Annexure-I aforesaid.

5. Disqualification.

No person,

- a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; OR
- b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Mizorum may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exampt any person from the operation of these Rules.

6. Training and Departmental Examination.

Every Govt. servant recruited under these trades shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

7. Power to transfer etc.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the vernor of Mizoram in public interest small have the right and power to transfer an officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

8. Power to relax.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Departmental Promotion Committe/Mizoram Public Service Commission as the case may be, through the Depart of Personnel & Admn. Reforms, relax any of the provisors of these Rules with respect to any class or categories of persons.

9. Reservation and other concessions.

Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizorara from time to time in this regard.

10. Repeal and Savings.

All Rules pertaining to these post framed by the Govt. of Assam or Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMP framed by the Govt. of Mizoram vide Notification No. A. 12018/21/86-APT (B) dated 20.3.89 and published in the Mizoram Gazette, Volume XVIII, Issue No. 22 (A) dated 20.3.89 prior to the commencement of these Rules stand hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
