NOTIFICATION

THE RULES OF THE GAUHATI HIGH COURT (THE HIGH COURT OF ASSAM, NAGALAND, MEGALAYA, MANIPUR, TRIPURA, MIZORAM AND ARUNACHAL PRADESH) (2ND AMENDMENT RULES, 1998.

No. HC. XI-06/96/(Pt)/4575-4624/RC, the 27.11.98. 1. This Rules shall be called the Gauhati High Court (High Court of Assam, Nagaland, Meghalaya, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram & Arunachal Pradesh) (2nd Amendment) Rules, 1998, here-in-after referred as "Amending Rules."

- 2. The Amending Rules shall come into force with immediate effect.
- 3. Definition: "The Rules" mean the Gauhati High Court (The High Court of Assam, Nagaland, Meghalaya, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram & Arunachal Pradesh) Rules.
- 4. Sub-Rule (a) of Rule I under Chapter I of Part-I of the Gauhati High Court Rules shall stand amended as follows:—

"Rule 1(a):— The Full Court Meeting will normally sit with all the Judges of the Principal Seat as well as the Outlying Benches of this Court at least thrice in a year.

Provided that in exceptional/emergent circumstances, the full Court may sit with the Judges available at the Principal Seat to deal with any matter which, in the opinion of the Chief Justice, requires immediate disposal.

Provided further that the Full Court Meeting beld both in normal and exceptional/emergent circumstances must have the quoram of one-third of the total number of Judges of the High Court in position."

Explanation:— Any resolution adopted in the Meeting of the Full Court in exceptional/emergent circumstances—shall be circulated to all the Judges of the Outlying Benches.
