#### NOTIFICATION

No. B. 11015/1/96-L&E, the 4th January, 1999. In exercise of the power conferred under Section 5(1)(a) of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to re-constitute a State Level Committee on Minimum Wages to review Minimum Wages and advise Government of Mizoram in respect of the re-fixation of Minimum rates of Wages for persons working under any scheduled/casual employment within the State of Mizoram consisting the following members :—

1. Secretary, Labour & Employment	—	Chairman
2. Director, Labour & Employment	—	Member-Secretary
3. Chief Engineer, P. W. D.	—	Member

2. The terms of reference of the Committee will be as follows :—

- 1) It will review the prevailing rates of wages of persons engaged of scheduled/casual employment considering prices Index in Local Markets, etc.
- 2) It will submit its proposals to the Govt. of Mizoram for refixation of Minimum Wages of persons employed under any scheduled employment at interval of at least every 2 (two) years.
- 3) If may recommend suitable enforcement machinery.

3. The term of Office of the Committee shall be for a period of 2 (two) years from the date of this Notification unless extended.

4. Non-Official members of the Committee will be entitled to T. A. and D. A. like Group 'A' Officers of the Government.

5. The Committee will submit its reports/advise to the Government of Mizoram within 3 (three) months from its first sitting to consider revision of existing Minimum Wages by Government.
