NOTIFICATION

No. 100/MIZ-LA/1/99(i). WHEREAS, the seat of Shri Zoramthanga, in the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram, elected from 14-Khawbung (ST) Assembly Constituency, has become vacant on 08.12.98, by reason of his resignation.

- (2) WHEREAS, a bye-election is to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy so caused;
- (3) NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of Sub-Section (1) of Section 150, and sections 30 & 56 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission of India hereby-
 - (A) calls upon the said 14-Khawbung (ST) Assembly Constituency in the State of Mizoram, to elect, before 26.02.99 (Friday) and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the Rules and Orders made thereunder, a person, belonging to any of the Scheduled Tribes of the State, for the purpose of filling the said vacancy in the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram;
 - (B) appoints, with respect to the said election-
 - (a) the 5th February, 1999 (Friday), as the last date for making nominations;

- (b) the 6th February, 1999 (Saturday), as the date for the scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) the 8th February, 1999 (Monday), as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 22nd February, 1999 (Monday), as the ast date on which a poll shall, if necessary be taken; and
- (e) the 26th February, 1999 (Friday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and
- (C) fixes the hours from 7:00 a.m to 4:00 p.m as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken on the date specified above for the election.
