- 2. The Committee may Co-opt any official or non-official as additional member.
- 3. The terms of reference of the Committee will be as follows:
 - 1) To review the present Land Regulations and Rules/Act.
 - 2) To examine the draft Revenue Acts and make recommendations.
 - 3) To study any tour issue related to land reforms and make recommendations relating thereto.

- 4. T.A/D.A. of non-official members who will be entitled to draw T.A/D.A. at the rates admissible to Group 'A' Officers of Mizoram Government will be paid by the Revenue Department.
- 5. The Committee may finalise its report within 3 (three) months i.e. by 31st May, 1999.
