THE SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PENSION OF MEMBERS OF
PARLIAMENT (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1999

(No. 6 OF 1999)

Promulgated by the President in the Forty-ninth Year of the Republic of
India.

An Ordinance further to amend the Salary, Allowances and Pension of
Members of Parliament Act, 1954.

WHEREAS Parliament is not in session, and the President is satisfied that
circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (I) This Ordinance may be called the Salaries, Allowances and Pension of Members of Parliament (Amendment) Ordinance, 1999. Short title and commencement

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Insertion of new section 8AA. 2. After section 8A of the Salary, Allowances and Pension of Members of Parliament Act, 1954, the following section shall be inserted, namely:— 30 of 1954.

Travel facility to ex-members. “8AA. With effect from the commencement of the Salary, Allowances and Pension of Members of Parliament (Amendment) Ordinance, 1999, every person who is not a sitting member but has served for any period as a member of either House of Parliament shall be entitled along with a companion to travel in any train by any railway in India in air-conditioned two-tier class without payment of any charges on the basis of an authorisation issued for this purpose by the Secretariat of either House of Parliament, as the case may be.”
